Summer STEAM Explorer will run over three weekends in April. The Explorers will learn about the history of water in London and how it is connected to this site, how the engines on this site work and how to take care of them, culminating in the experience of firing up the boiler and assisting in the running of the Engines for a Steam Up Event.

STEAM Explorer is aimed at young people aged 13-17. Participation in the club is free thanks to the generous support and funding of the Water Conservation Trust.

Sessions will be held at the London Museum of Water & Steam, Green Dragon Lane, Brentford, London TW8 0EN.

The club will be delivered by Danielle Holmes (Engagement and Interpretation Officer) and Richard Albanese (Project Manager and Engineer), alongside a team of engineering volunteers.
